

Questioning Evangelism

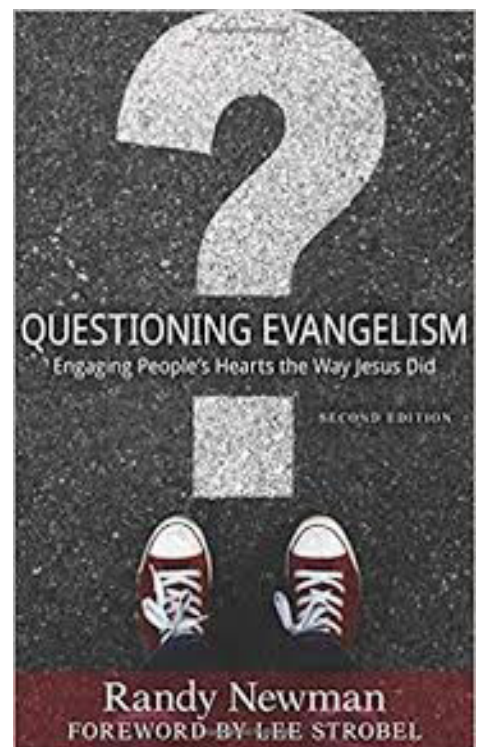

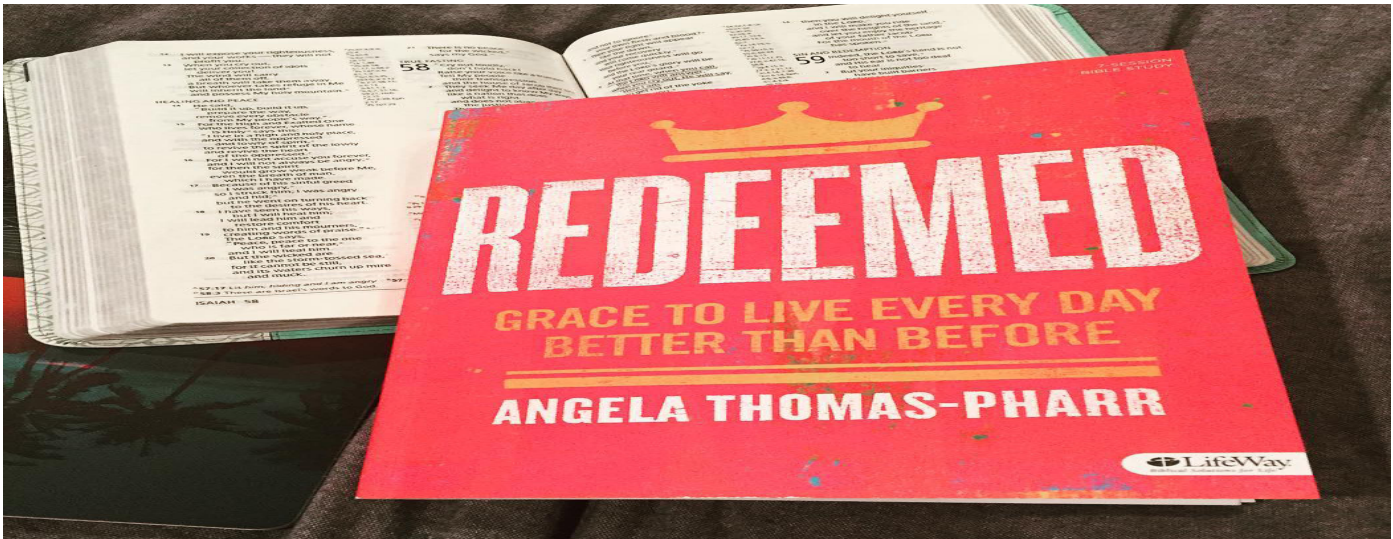
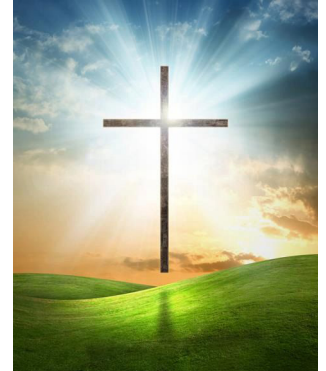
