

A Letter From Christ First Counseling Center



Thank you to all who attended our Lunch and Learn for Christ First Counseling Center back in March! We hope that you found the information valuable and that you have been able to utilize their services, share their mission with someone who could use it, or found a way to support their ministry. We wanted to share a letter received from Christ First Counseling Center with you:

Greetings Friends,

It was such a joy and honor to speak with you last month at the lunch and learn and share more about our ministry and how we are working to meet the mental health needs in our community by providing high quality, compassionate care with highly trained counselors. I enjoyed talking with you during and after the event as you raised excellent questions about how mental health is being viewed and handled in today's society. You might remember a statistic I mentioned that in 2021, 80 thousand individuals did not seek out counseling services because of the cost. While we accept most insurances to help individuals and families who are able to use these benefits covered services, there is still a great need to serve a population who otherwise cannot afford it. This is why we began our Community Impact Grant. This grant allows for those who are unable to afford services to receive financial help so they can still receive care.

We also have a branch of our ministry dedicated to providing soul care for local business and ministry leaders called Renovate. Through the Renovate ministry, attendees will be given opportunities to grow and deepen their walk with the Father through retreats, group classes and one on one mentoring. In the 2 years since launching Renovate, we have been able to serve 164 individuals.

I would humbly ask that you consider giving to CFCC's Community Impact Grant Fund or the Renovate Ministry. God has been doing amazing things through CFCC and we need partnership from local community members like you to continue the Father's work here. We also need prayer partners who can lift our ministry, counselors and support staff up in prayer on a daily basis as we are on the front lines of some serious spiritual warfare in our culture.
