

Pastor Search Team Update by Heidi Langford



It's a day we have been waiting for. The team has been at work and preparing for months. The season has had its share of highs and lows, but the long-awaited event is in sight. February 11 is Super Bowl Sunday, and even more importantly, Seth Gheen is coming in view of a call!

At the Business Meeting on January 21, The Pastor Search Team (PST) summarized the background of their search and information about the pastor that they are presenting to NABC. Since May 4, 2022, the PST has met consistently, using the information that the church provided to the Transition Team, to sum up the top qualities and characteristics of our future pastor, prepare and submit a Job Posting Announcement, review 175 resumes, listen to countless hours of sermons, conduct multiple Zoom interviews, and (most importantly) pray for God's clear direction.

Seth Gheen submitted his resume on August 16, 2023. The PST had several Zoom meetings with him, and then had the opportunity to meet Seth in person on December 17, 2023.

Seth grew up in Colorado, became a Christian as a child, but recommitted his life to the Lord at age 22. He felt called into the ministry and received his Master of Theology degree from Dallas Theological Seminary. Seth became the Associate Pastor of Discipleship at Community Bible Church in Omaha, NE before following his God-given desire to serve as a chaplain. He is completing his commitment to the Army, serving as a Battalion Chaplain (Captain), shepherding and discipling soldiers and their families.

In his cover letter to the PST, Seth stated, "My goal at this stage of life is straightforward: find a Christ-centered, Bible teaching, multigenerational SBC church where I can serve and minister for the long term. I'm 36 years old and have many years of ministry ahead of me. My prayer is to find a church excited about fulfilling our call as Christ's body—a place where we can grow together."

The PST looks forward to introducing Seth, his wife Dana, and their three daughters (Thea, Gussie, and Maple) to NABC on Sunday, February 11. Seth will have the opportunity to preach in the worship service, as well as share his testimony and answer questions in the lunch Q&A at noon. A Specially Called Business Meeting will be held following this to vote on his coming in view of a call. We hope that you can join us on this important day!
